

Tourism in Puerto Rico is thriving, and exciting projects, initiatives, and businesses are constantly developing. Here's your monthly update for Q1 (January - March 2024) about the new developments on the Island that continue to improve the #LiveBoricua experience for visitors.

NORTH & METRO REGION

In the North & Metro region of the Island, Casa Costera Isla Verde Beach, a new apartment-style accommodation by Marriott Bonvoy opened in Isla Verde, and a new urban boutique guesthouse named Patio Elba opened in Santurce.

Additionally, the gastronomic offerings on the Island continue to diversify with the opening of a new Asian fusion restaurant in Liberty Square called Nacionsushi, a Japanese restaurant in La Concha Renaissance San Juan Resort called Tekka Bar: Handroll & Sake, and a champagne and caviar bar by chef Juan Jose Cuevas called Marabar by 1919 in the Condado Vanderbilt lobby. Also, there are two new restaurants in San Juan: Bartolo Miramar, a traditional Puerto Rican restaurant, and Basilisa, a new Spanish Puerto Rican fusion restaurant.

CENTRAL REGION

In the Central Region of the Island, a new venue and gastronomic space opened in Cidra. Aldeana is a culinary establishment founded by three renowned Puerto Rican chefs: Raul Correa, Rene Marichal, and Xavier Pacheco.

COMMS TEAM RECOMMENDATIONS

The internal Communications Team continues to research and coordinate site inspections in different restaurants, hotels, and attractions to connect and explore collaboration opportunities with potential partners. A few of the places the Communications Team visited during Q1 were the following:

Aldeana – A gastronomic space ideal for weddings, and private events. In addition to this, they also offer culinary events during the weekends.

Furtivo - Furtivo is a speakeasy bar located in Condado that offers a variety of cocktails and tapas. The bar opens every day of the week and serves as a space for small events for up to 60 people.

Hisoka Na - Hisoka Na is the first japanese tea garden in the Island, offering a variety of over 80 teas and infusions, each with a unique blend of local and international herbs.

Finca La Zafra – This family-run agroecological company in Gurabo generates dining and agricultural experiences designed for visitors, and corporate and social events. Their restaurant opens on Saturdays.
