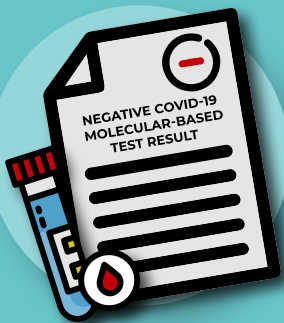


SAN JUAN AIRPORT PROTOCOL

Puerto Rico is committed to providing a safe travel experience. Recognizing the importance of hygiene and disinfection, the Island of Puerto Rico is applying locally enforced measures to safeguard the wellbeing of guests and residents.

WHEN TRAVELING TO PUERTO RICO, THE FOLLOWING IS REQUIRED PRIOR TO ARRIVAL:

1. Negative Molecular Test Result:



Arrive with proof of a negative COVID-19 molecular-based test taken no more than 72 hours prior to visiting the Island. Travelers with no evidence of negative molecular test will remain in quarantine at their own expense for 14 days.



2. Travel Declaration Form:

Complete Travel Declaration Form which can be found at www.travelsafe.pr.gov.



3. Wear a Mask or Face Covering:

Masks or face coverings are mandatory at airport and public areas, or individuals will be subject to a fine.
